Trey's for a Fish Tank / aquarium for under \$15**

Supply's

First thing is the Egg crate stuff.



I bought this sheet at Home Depot for about \$10.00 "46 x 22" "homedepot.com"

"It is the Stuff for Drop celling Light Fixtures" Don't ask them for Egg crate, They look at you funny.

Next Item In the Home Depot to get is the medium size plungers Thing's "about \$1.98 for 4"





The Tool's that is needed is a set of cutter's OR Saw “cutter's at a dollar store \$1 “

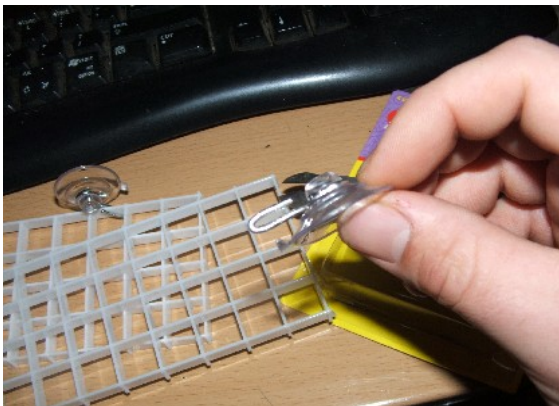


I used The simple Cutters and Cut out the size of rack I wanted.

**UPDATE::**

“Then you remove the little metal hook that was on the plunger.”

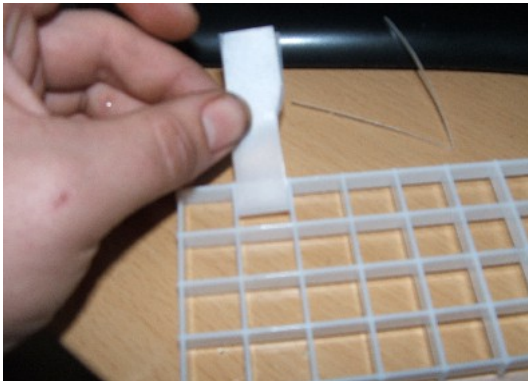
At [Michigan Reefers](#) I had this book posted and they pointed out that it would be easy to cause problems in the water. So I decided to play it safe.



Remove the metal clip “yes it works, But not a Good Idea, Trust me, What we use to Replace the Clip works better anyways.



Find a Plastic Milk Jug, And Cut Strips out of it to fit Snug in the Egg Crate Holes.



They Don't need to be very Long, I started with them about 4 ½ inches long Unfolded.  
You can Trim it after the suction cup is in place.



Get a Hole Punch, its Perfect Size for the medium cups.

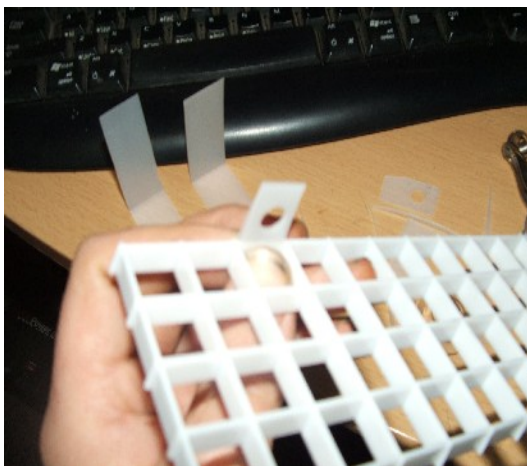


My Racks were only about 8 inches by 3 inches, so I only needed 2 plungers per rack.

Fold the strips in Half, and slide over the egg crate.

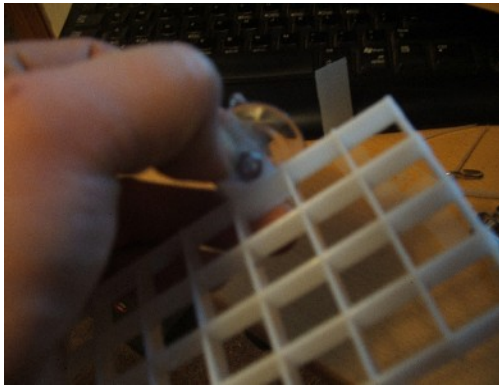
Try and get close to the egg crate when punching to hole, it will help keep the self from falling down.

If you find it wants to fall simply put a little drop of the saltwater Glue on the strip and hold it in place for a few.





Next, Insert the suction cup,, It should be a really Tight fit. But work at it while turning the cup, I found as soon as one side got into the grove the rest would screw into place.



Then Install.



Done, A nice Simple Frag rack.



The only Problem is I had a lot of this egg crate left over, So I would Suggest to ask around to find someone that might have scrap chunks of it.. Or set up a Full Frag Tank.. or get a full sheet and share with your friend. Me, I made a few for friend's, and figured maybe one day I might set up a Frag Tank.
